Lustre played MonDak at home on Tuesday, Sept 10. The teams were quite matched and

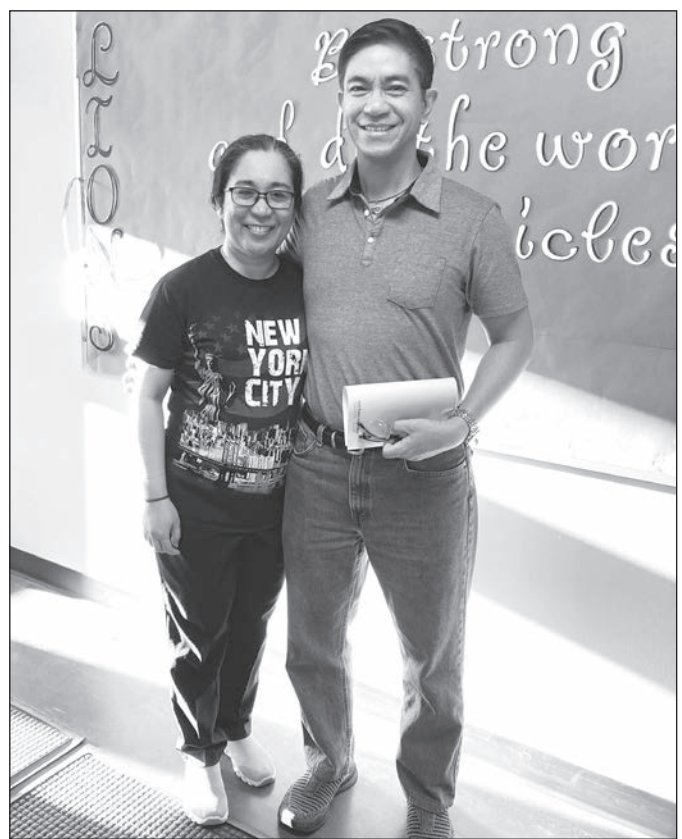

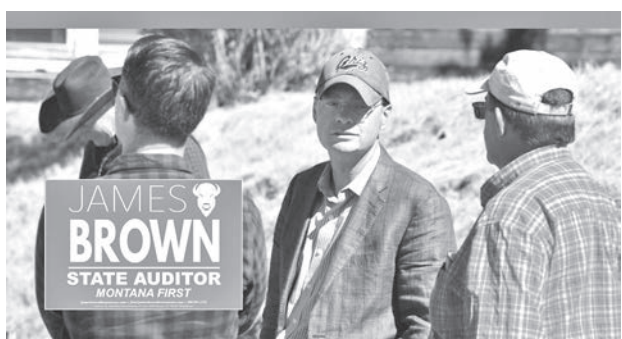

Mountain Standard Time, on October 2, 2024.** Bids must be addressed and delivered to **City Clerk Stacey Amundson, C/O Glasgow City Hall, 319 3rd St. S Glasgow, MT 59230.** Bids will be publicly opened and announced by the City of Glasgow at 2:00 P.M. Mountain Standard Time on October 2, 2024, at Glasgow City Hall. No bids may be withdrawn after the scheduled time for the bid opening.

The work generally consists of:

- 1.A.1 Base Bid:
 - 1.A.1.a The work generally consists of constructing a new 1,849 sqft CMU block bathhouse with new fixtures, plumbing, electrical and sidewalks.

The contract may be awarded based on the OWNER's best interests. The award will be based on the lowest cost combination of responsive, responsible bids on the Base Bid and Additive Alternate selected by the OWNER.

CONTRACTOR is required to have registered with the DLI prior to bidding on this project and all laborers and mechanics employed by the CONTRACTOR or Subcontractors in performance of the construction work shall be paid wages at rates as required by the Laws of the State of Montana. The CONTRACTOR must ensure that employees and applicants for employment are not discriminated against because of their race, color, religion, sex, or national origin.

PUBLIC OPPORTUNITY TO PROTEST TRANSFER OF OWNERSHIP OF Montana All-Alcoholic Beverages License

POOT'S PLACE LLC (Josh Tihista, Owner(s)) has applied to transfer Montana All-Alcoholic Beverages License No. 20-230-8797-001 to be operated at DINK'S BAR, 54247 Us Highway 2, Glasgow, Valley County. The public may protest this license transfer in accordance with the law.

Who can protest this transfer? Protests will be accepted from residents of the county of the proposed location Valley County, residents of adjoining Montana counties, and residents of adjoining counties in another state if the criteria in 16-4-207(4)(d), Montana Code Annotated (MCA), are met.

What information must be included? Protest letters must be legible and contain (1) the protestor's full name, mailing address, and street address; (2) the license number 20-230-8797-001 and the applicant's name POOT'S PLACE LLC; (3) an indication that the letter is intended as a protest; (4) a description of the grounds for protesting; and (5) the protestor's signature. A letter with multiple signatures will be considered one protest letter.

What are valid protest grounds? The protest may be based on the applicant's qualifications listed in 16-4-401, MCA, or the grounds for denial of an application in 16-4-405, MCA. Examples of valid protest grounds include: (1) the applicant is unlikely to operate the establishment in compliance with the law; (2) the proposed location cannot be properly policed by local authorities; and (3) the welfare of the people in the vicinity of the proposed location will be adversely and seriously affected.

How are protests submitted? Protests must be postmarked to the Department of Revenue, Office of Dispute Resolution, P.O. Box 5805, Helena, Montana 59604-5805 on or before October 5, 2024.

What happens if the transfer is protested? Depending on the number of protests and the protest grounds, a public hearing will be held in Helena or Glasgow. All valid protesters will be notified of the hearing's time, date and location. Hearings typically are scheduled within 90 days. A protester's hearing testimony is limited to the grounds in the protestor's letter. Following the hearing, the Department of Revenue will notify the public whether the license transfer is approved or denied.
